 The Last Will and Testament of John Arguerette
 of St. Marys Camden County
 Georgia

I John Arguerette Considering the uncertainty
 of this mortal life and being of sound mind
 and Memory do make one publick this my
 last Will and Testament in manner and form
 following (that is to say) First I give
 and bequeath unto my wife Susan Fanny
 my Negro Woman Rachel then I
 give and bequeath unto my two Children
 George and Roselina Arguerette all and
 every part of my property (except the negro
 Woman above named) Whither Real
 personal or mixed to be divided equally
 between them - provided however that
 should my said housekeeper Fanny be
 delivered of another Child within nine
 months from the date hereof the said Child
 is to have an equal share with the first
 before named and I hereby appoint
 Thomas as the Miller Esquire sole Executor
 to this my last Will and Testament hereby
 revoking all former Wills by me made
 and I hereby commit the Guardianship
 of my said Children Untill they
 shall respectively attain the age of
 twenty one years unto Samuel
