 make this my last will and testament here
 by Revoking all former ones to wit
 I desire at my decease that my Body be
 decently Buried without pomp or show
 then my legal and Just Debts promptly
 and punctually paid Secondly I desire that
 the Dollars should be paid to my Daughter
 Mary Summerlin wife of Jacob Summerlin
 Thirdly that I desire that one hundred
 dollars be paid to my Daughter Hoziah
 Hagin when she comes of age
 Fourthly I desire that one Hundred Dollars
 be paid to my Eldest Son Ipe Hagin when
 he comes of age
 Fifthly I desire that one hundred Dollars
 be paid to my Daughter Elizabeth Hagin
 when she comes of age. Sixthly I desire
 one hundred Dollars be paid to my Son
 John H. Hagin when he comes of age
 Seventhly I desire that one hundred Dollars
 be paid to my Daughter Sarian Hagin
 when she comes of age. I further desire
 that one hundred Dollars be paid to the
 Rest of my lawfull Children if any when
 they come of age. also I further desire
 that all the property containing

 Slaves during my life & widowhood
 at the expiration of which I desire that all the
 above mentioned property should be equally
 divided amongst all my lawfull heirs
 and I do further appoint William
 Tinscott of the County of Hays in the

 of the County and State above mentioned
 my lawfull Executors to this my last
 Will and Testament in witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the
 second day of October in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 twenty two
