 Testament

First. Should it please God to remove me before
 the Expiration of the present year of our Lord
 One Thousand eight Hundred and nineteen
 It is my wish that my Executors provide a
 Suitable person whose Humanity can be
 relied on to superintend the Completing my
 present Affair As soon as the Sale of the Same
 Can be accomplished it is my desire that all
 my last Debts in the State of Georgia be
 immediately paid

Second My next desire is that my Six following
 Negroes viz Jim, Nicco, Jack, Sophy and her
 two Children Colerain and Sybilra be disposed
 of at Private Sale to persons resident in the
 Country Sophy and her two Children by no
 means to be Separated My object in preferring
 a private Sale is that Faithful and human
 owners ~~be~~ may be Selected by Executors
 are requested to bear this in mind

Third The few articles of Furniture Such as
 may be found in my dwelling House (with
 the Exception of Such as may be otherwise
 disposed of) I leave to be Equally divided
 Between Mr Williams and Morrisson

Fourth It is my request of my neighbor
 Mr J. H. McIntosh that he cause to be distrained
 all papers Letters &c which may be found
 in my House not appearing with presen-
 tion and thus he return (should he de-
 cide worth his acceptance)

also he may find in my promises that may
belong to me and be not requisite for the
comfort of my negroes should Mr. M. D. be
consider them not worth his removal my
desire is that Mr. M. D. and Williams
have them It is my further desire
should I die possessed of a House that
the same be appropriated by my friend
William Gibson

5th. After all my above expressed desires
shall be accomplished and all Charges
defrayed it is my next desire that the
whole amount that shall remain in the
hands of my Executors together with a
Certified Copy of this my last will &
Testament be forthwith remitted to my
friend Col. W. Drayton in S. Carolina to
be disposed of by him as follows

First The whole of my last debts in Carolina
to be paid out of the same including all
debts contracted originally by me as well as
sums paid by my Executors with interest thereon
Second The sum then remaining it is
my wish that Col. Drayton appropriate to his
own use the sum of Three hundred Dollars

Third The residue (if amounting to a sum
large enough to be advantageously placed
at interest) it is my wish be placed in the
most prudent way according to the
discretion of Col. Drayton for the Benefit and
use of my unfortunate niece Susan
Parker daughter of my Brother George
Should the above sum be too small to be
placed at interest advantageously it is my
desire it be paid into the hands of my executors

and for the life and benefit
of the poor to be removed my estate
from the debts of my mother the above
said to legally directed to be done by
and his wife

last of my last will and Testament
I nominate constitute and appoint my
Trusted & Beloved and William Selwyn
(my Executors)

My Minors whereof John Parker the eldest
have to this day made sundry orders
that of paper, money, land and such
kind of business as appertains to the estate
and the said John Parker and his Executors

have been published and
declared by the above named
John Parker as and for his
last will and Testament in
the presence of us Magistrate
