

Last Will & Testament of Joseph B. Rain.

State of Georgia

Camden County, } In the Name of God, Amen.
I, Joseph B. Rain, of said State and
County, being of Advanced age, but of
sound and disposing mind and Memory,
and knowing the uncertainty of human
life deem it right and proper that I should
make a disposition of the property which
a kind Providence has blessed me,
I do therefore make this my last Will &
Testament, hereby revoking and annulling
all others by me heretofore made.

Item 1st - I desire and direct that my body be
buried in a decent and Christian like
manner suitable to my Circumstances
and Condition in life. My Soul, I Trust
shall return to rest with God who gave
it as I hope for Salvation through the
Merits and Atonement of the Blessed
Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Item 2^d - I desire and direct that all my just
debts be paid as soon as practicable after
my death.

Item 3^d - I give bequeath and devise to my
beloved Wife, Sarah J. - all my property,
both real and personal for and during
her natural lifetime absolutely and
and for her use and benefit, and at
her death, should she die intestate to my
Nephew Nathaniel J. Paterson and his
half sister Mary J. Watson, Share and
Share alike, And it is my Will and

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that the portion falling to said Mary & Watson shall not in any way be subject to the debts, liabilities or contracts of any husband that she may have.

And it is my desire and request that should my said wife Sarah see fit to make a Will before her death, that if right and practicable she carry out the bequests as stated in 3^d Item of this my Will.

Item 5th - I hereby constitute and appoint my wife, Sarah J. Rain, Executrix of this my last Will and Testament
