

Y B Richards Will

In the name of God Amen I Anne B Richards (widow) of the County of Camden in the State of Georgia being sick and weak in body but of sound mind and memory do hereby certify for the same do make this my last will and Testament following hereby revoking and making void all other wills by me made

1 I desire that all my just debts be paid as soon after my decease as may be convenient

2 I give and bequeath to my daughter Clementine Sanders a woman named Michel and also Clara Sophia Reese Lucy Paddy and Sam Slaves belonging to me

3 I give and bequeath to Clarissa Betsey Anne and John W Richards the minor children of my late Son William B Richards the following Negro Slaves to wit to Clarissa Charles and Harriet to Betsey Ann Bonnie and Maurice and to John W Rich and Louis and Sonnet with their future issue and increase and it is my wish and desire that after my death the aforesaid described Slaves be kept in the hands of my Son John Richards to be by him delivered over to each of my said named Grand Children on their severally arriving to the age of Twenty one years

4 I give and bequeath to my Son Francis Richard a mulatto boy named Tony with the following property to wit a pair of horses named Harry and Jeff and a mare named Mary Son John B

Richards a negro man named Bill and the following other Slaves Francis, William, Black, Henry, Mariah, Nancy, Dick, James also my best tools furniture a large Canvas boat barrels Gold Watch and Chain three or four of my and plantation tools and utensils in all left out by order of Court

5 I give and bequeath all the rest of my Estate Real and personal to my children and Grand Children herein before named to be divided as follows one fourth to my daughter Clementine one fourth to my Son Charles Clarissa Betsey Anne and John W Richards one fourth to Frederick Richards and the remainder one fourth to my Son John B Richards and I hereby nominate and appoint my Son B Richards Executor of this my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have set my hand and Seal this Twenty first day of December one thousand eight hundred and twenty

This will is signed and published by the above named Anne B Richards at and in her last will and Testament in the presence of us who at her request and in her presence have subscribed our names as Witnesses thereto
