thousand dollars; I give & bequeath to nephew
John Clark my old watch; to my Sister
Anne Macpherson or mourning ring with
my hair; and a like mourning ring to
Ellen McDonald and I give devise and bequest
unto my beloved wife Louisa C Shaw all the
residue of my estate both real and personal
of what nature or kind down or wheresoever
the same shall be at the time of my
death; and I do hereby nominate, constitute
and appoint my said wife sole Executrix of
this my last Will and Testament, hereby
revoking and making Void all and every
other Will or Wills heretofore by me
made, and do declare this my last Will
and Testament, and I do hereby recommend
to the affection and Care of my beloved wife
my much loved children, in Case She Should
at any time during her life die
of palsy, and
