in further request and direct my Executors
to keep the plantation which I now
live on for the joint use & benefit
of herself & my Child & that it shall
not be sold or disposed of until my
Child Jane Spalding comes of Lawful
age & then if it should be to their
interest or wish to divide or sell
it is my wish they do so

I further Order & direct that in
case my said Child Jane Spalding
should die without Lawful issue
her body then and in that case the
property I here leave to her shall be
equally divided share & share alike to
my two Natural Children Sally
Tabach & Isham Spalding
