Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my beloved
Robert Thomas all that part of my Bullheads
tract of Land which lies on the West Side of Bull
Creek in Camden County

Fifthly I give and bequeath unto my beloved
Daughter Thomas one equal half of all the
tract of Land Situated near the town of Camden
clearly in the County of Orange and known
by the name of the College Plantation
which parts or parcels of said Land I have bequeathed
to my Sons Joseph Thomas Robert Thomas and
Charles Thomas and above described that be
to them as they severally arrive to the age
of twenty one years not allowing them to
any and for the same

and her heirs and heirs forever the one half of what
shall be allowed to her on the first day of
next and the other one half of what
