of her natural life all my property whether
real or personal of whatever kind or sort
I may be in possession at my death and at
her death I give the same to my daughter
Jane Farley Pratt and I do hereby appoint
Lalah Wood my wife Jane F Pratt & the Executors
I Pratt Executors of this my Will and I do
also by this Indenture revoke & make void
all my former Wills & Testaments & declare this
to be my only Will
