named Isaac, one Hundred dollar Cash
all when he arrives at the age of Twenty
one year.

I give unto my Daughter Frances
one eighth of lot N. 8 in the town of St.
Marys and one Hundred Dollar Cash
the lot to be delivered at this present, the
Cash to be paid on the first of January
one thousand ~~and~~ eight Hundred and
two.

I give unto my Daughter Mary Ann
one eighth of lot N. 8 in the town
Marys, one Negro girl named Lill
and one Hundred dollar Cash all
when she arrives at the age of eight.

I give my son Robert one fourth
of lot N. 8 in the Town of St. Marys, a
Negro fellow named Dembo and one
Hundred Dollar Cash, all to be de-
livered when he arrives at the age of
Twenty one.

I Bequeath unto my beloved
wife Elizabeth all the rest of my

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property, I do leave my Wife Elizabeth
Executor of the my last Will and Testament
I give, devise and bequeath all and every
my mynaye land tenements and Chur-
chments, Whatsoever, which I allow have
with the payments of my said Legacy, in
Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal the tenth day of
August in the Year of our Lord one
thousand eight Hundred and
