I Langley Bryant of State and County aforesaid being well advanced in years and in a feeble state of health and knowing the uncertainty of human existence, have deemed advisable to make my approaching end in a Christian like manner and with a wish to settle my affairs as far as in my power lies, do make, constitute, assign, and confirm this my last Will and Testament.

First I hereby do appoint nominate and constitute my good true and lawful wife all my Bryant and daughter, James Bryant, Allen Thomas, and William Jackson my Executors to have the whole management of my Estate after my departure in the manner herein after mentioned.

Secondly, I hereby give the use of my fellow slave and his sister Abby, to my son John Bryant and to my daughter Easter I give the use of my Negro bond Rochel, until my youngest son Sill Bryant shall come of age.

Thirdly, I do hereby will and give to my wife in charge the whole of my personal and real estate, until my youngest son Sill shall come to the age of Twenty One years, at which time it is my will and pleasure that each of my children,

James, Langley, Sill, and my daughters Easter, and Rebecca, have an Equal share with my good and lawful wife, Mary Bryant, and the death of my wife has she to be Equally divided between my children as above named.
