happiness beyond the Grave through the mercy
and merits of the Saviour of Mankind

As to my worldly estates I give devise and bequeath
in the same in manner and form following

First To my niece Lucy Ann Barnes, I give
the Sum of Five Hundred dollars to be paid to her
by my Executors herein after named Within Six
Months after my decease to her absolute use
Forever

Second To my Grand daughter Mary Martha Tier
I give devise and bequeath the Sum of one thousand
and dollars, upon her Marriage or arriving
at the age of Twenty one years but my Will is
desire is that the said Money shall be invested
by my Executors together with such dividends
as may from time to time accrue thereon in
Bank Stock of some good Bank at their discre-
tion - and in their names - and upon the Mar-
riage of the said Mary Martha Tier or upon her
arriving at the age of Twenty one years that
my said Executors do

Upon the request of the said Mary Martha
Hew, upon transfer to her the duplicate of
said Book as well original as accumulated
to her, only and in the last power but of
my said grand daughter the said Mary Martha
Hew shall dec. before she arrives at the age
of twenty one years to marriage, then
my will and desire is, that the said sum of
one thousand dollars, or at the same has
been invested in bank stock, then that the
said Book, and all the accumulated dividends
thereof shall go to and be vested in my
son Robert James Delaney and my daughter
Elizabeth B. Berrien the wife of John Richard
Mc Berrien their heirs and assigns as tenants
in common and not as joint tenants, in
equal moieties

Lastly I give devise and bequeath to all the
asset and residue of my estate whether real or
personal, whether in possession or in action
and of whatever kind or denominations, to my
affectionate son Robert James Delaney, and my
affectionate daughter Elizabeth B. Berrien to
them their heirs and assigns forever there
and share alike, as tenants in common, and
not as joint tenants. And I do nominate
and appoint John Richard Mc Berrien and
my son Robert James Delaney executors of
this my last will and testament, hereby
revoking all other wills by me at any
