I Maria Floyd of the County of Camden and
State of Georgia, being of sound and disposing
mind and Memory, do make publish and declare
this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking
all others and Making null and Void all other
last Wills and Testaments by me at any time heretofore
made

And as to my worldly estate and all the property
real and personal of which I shall die seized
and possessed, or to which I shall be entitled at
the time of my decease, I give and bequeath
and dispose thereof in the manner following
to-wit:—

Item First, — If after the time of my death I shall
be seized and possessed, and be in the actual
occupation with my family of a home or res-
idence, I request and desire that my said
husband John Floyd, shall have the use of
such home and residence for and during the
term of his natural life, and from and after
his death the said home or residence shall go to
my son Charles A Floyd, who shall have the use
of such home or residence, during the term of
his natural life, and from and after his death
the said home or residence shall go to my sons
son Duane Floyd and Charles Floyd jr.

Item Second —

I give bequeath and desire to my son
son Duane Floyd, one lot in the City of St Mary
Ga. described as follows — to-wit: Situate in
Block No 2; and Commencing at the south
East Corner of said Block, and running West,

Seventy (170) feet on Ailey, thence running South
Eighty (80) feet, thence running West Seventy
(70) feet, thence running South Sixty (60) feet
on Wheeler Street to the place of Beginning.

I also give and devise to my grandson
Oswald Floyd, one half of the Homestead good
and true Both Corn,
Slaves Here -

I give bequest and devise to my grand
son Charles Floyd Jr, and my grand daughter
Blanchette Floyd, one lot in the City of St Mary
Ga, described as follows. To wit, situated
in Block No Two (2) - And running South for
70 feet, from the South East Corner of said Block
on the Ailey and running West Seventy five (75)
feet west on said Ailey, thence running North
Eighty five (85) feet, thence running East Seventy
five (75) feet, thence running North Sixty five (65)
feet to the place of Beginning.
