 make this My last will and Testament in the manner
 and form following - -

First. I will that all My Just debts & all accompan-
 tions & services be paid for which purpose and
 settling these accounts & the latter Carrying this
 Will into Effect I do hereby Appoint son Leon
 Duvengauze my Only Executor & Charge the rest
 of My Children to pay him a Commission for his
 trouble - - -

Secondly. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Louise
 Arment Fortest for the Use of her Children
 in Joint property, fifteen hundred dollars - -

Thirdly. To My four Daughters, Louise, Harman, Mar-
 garette, Estunelle, Maria, Catherine, Theodore &
 Maria Louise Anne, I give all My remaining
 Apprais'd & Ready to be divided equally among them

Fourthly. I give to the Negro Women Gabate & Cely after
 two Years Service for My Children the
 Freedom & to the boy Carmot his Freedom
 after three Years Service the Calculation

Calculations, of this time to begin at my brother
and I Charges my Executor after Clermont's time
is Out and he is free to bind him to a trade
according to the Choice of said Bro. and to advance
Out of my Estate twenty five Dollars for the purpose
of Cloathing & binding him to said Trade, —
Fifthly, I give & bequeath to my Children I aim —
Jacques Les Duncans, wheday, Peupont Jean
Jacob Titon, Louis, Germain, Marguerite, Charlotte
Etienne, Catherine, Theodore & Elana, Louise divine
all the remaining part of my property to be divid-
ed equally between them —

Sixthly, in case any of my Children should die
without issue before my decease I will
that their part of the property should be divided
equally among the rest of my Children or their
Heirs. —

Seventhly, I do hereby declare this to be my last
Will and Testament nothing all other Wills or
Wills as void & of No Effect whatever.
