 a Negro Girl named John a Negro Boy named George & fifty Head of Black
 Cattle I also give & bequeath unto my young
 9th Daughter Sarah a Certain Negro Girl
 named Ben as a Negro Boy named Henry &
 fifty Head of Black Cattle & lastly unto my
 Daughter to follow the Summons of her Aunts & Uncle
 and the Rest of my Estate both real & personal
 to remain as it now stands & in possession of
 my wife Susan for the maintenance of my
 4th Son James youngest Children & to be paid
 when I shall think as long as my love to the Virgin
 will to be paid shall seem proper & as for
 Children that receive of any each to receive
 an Equal proportion But in case my wife
 and I should marry her for a third time I will bequeath
 to my four youngest Children & be equally
 divided among them & they each individually
 & severally to have & to hold their property
 & Mill to their use & behoof to them their heirs
 & assigns forever
