

A. Gascoyne Will.

In the Name of God. Amen I Richard Gascoyne
of the Town of St Marys County of Camden and
State of Georgia being at present of sound Mind and
Memory, but considering the Uncertainty of life, and
of Death, do make, my last will and testament in
the Manner and form following To-wit:

Firstly, I give and bequeath to Mr. Richard M. Smith
all my wearing apparel, and whatever I owe
he may be indebted to me at my decease.

Secondly, I write that all my just debts be paid

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for which purpose and for securing them due me
I hereby appoint my friend William Gibson my
only executor.

Thirdly, I give to the said William Gibson One Eighth part of
my property of all denominations at my decease
that in England & Wales.

Fourthly, the other seven Eighths of my property I give and
bequeath to my Sisters Mary & Elizabeth Garcoigne of
Rugby, which my Executor will have forwarded as
he may collect it, after defraying me 4 pence of
Barrat &c, what may accrue on my Estate, all
expences are to be borne proportionally.

Fifthly, I declare this to be my last will & Testament.
revoking & Considering as Null & Void all other wills
heretofore made.
