

Last Will and Testament of R. N. King
In the name of God, Amen.

Item 1st - It is my desire and intention that this shall be my last will and Testament, therefore all other Will, by me at any time heretofore made are hereby revoked.

Item 2nd. I hereby appoint my wife Carrie F. King as Executrix of this my last Will and Testament with full power to do and perform all acts hereinafter directed without the legal formalities of making annual returns to the Ordinary or of securing Order from Court to sell property when it is found expedient, and make such sale.

Item 3rd. I desire and direct that all my just debts shall be paid.

Item 4th. I hereby give and bequeath all my personal property of every character and description except notes due me, together with my home place known as Woodlawn including about two hundred and fifty (250) Acres of Land belonging to said home place, also about four hundred Acres of wild land bounded on the West by my said home place, on the North by lands of Julius King, on the East by lands of Joseph Mills Sr and C. M. Sheffield, and on the South by lands of W. N. King, Estate of April Wesley and W. F. Allen, to my said wife Carrie F. King and my two minor

Children, Archie and Layton, the said bequest to be used by my said wife for the maintenance of herself and two minor Children above mentioned.

Item 5th. I desire and direct that of the Four hundred Dollars (400) in Notes which I hold against Carvin Charles & Co. as soon as a sufficient amount is collected it shall be applied to the settlement of my just debts, and that the remainder shall be used in the maintenance and education of my said two minor Children Archie and Layton.

Item 6th. I give and bequeath to each of my other heirs as follows, to my son Julius King, One dollar, to my daughter Hettie Morrison, One dollar, to my son Edwin King, One dollar, to my daughter Jannette Belcher, One dollar, and to my Grandson Roy King, One dollar.

Witnesses they have and seal this 10th day of November A.D. 1896.
