In the name of God Amen

I Robert Rudolph, of the Town of St. Marys State of Georgia, being at present of sound Mind & memory, and knowing the uncertainty of life, do make this my last Will & Testament

In the manner & form following, Viz

Firstly, I constitute and appoint James Vincent of the Town of St. Marys & my beloved Wife Elizabeth Rudolph my Executors to carry this Will into effect.

Secondly, I will that all my Just debts be paid as soon as possible after my decease.

Thirdly, I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth Rudolph, the whole possession and entire use of all my property of whatever denomination, from my decease for and during the term of her natural life.

Fourthly, I give and bequeath to my Nephews, John Rudolph, Son of Zebulon, & to Francis Ripley, Son of Robert Ripley, the whole of my property of whatever denomination, to be divided equally between them, at the decease of my beloved Wife Elizabeth Rudolph & that my said Exrs. shall take charge of my said property, for them until they become of age, and do the best for their Interest, And in case of the decease of either of my said Nephews, before the term of age

Verd of either of my said Nephews, the next issue
Child of John Randolph or of Robert Ripley, shall
be Considered as legal Successors to their brother's
Share of the property hereafter as aforesaid
