be to God for the same and being desirous
to settle my worldly affairs whilst I have
Strength and Capacity so to do - Do
make and publish this my last Will and
Testament and first and chief principle
Consent of my said late Husband of my

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Creator, who gave the soul my body to the
earth, is he himself interested at the disunion
of my soul, his spirit, after death, and
his two frail, mortal, earthly, & therefore
his fleshly soul, of earthly, and of heaven
to the same or different worlds.

But I desire that all my just debts
be paid by my executor & pardon as just as
after my decease —

Richard I. give and bequeath to my son
William Patrick the more than one
Morg and the more One Acre. Ten
or thereabouts consist of many different of land
for given to my dearest & also a half
of the lot with improvements on which
most people being part of Original lot
numbered 100 in the County of Kings

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Being 1/2 ft. on either side adjoining
the lot now owned by John Dwyer & Son
Hundred feet deep

Fourth, I give and bequeath to my Son Charles
Esch, Son of Charles Johnston, and Charles
Storrs, Thomas Storrs, Margaret Storrs
and Samuel Storrs.

did & my daughter Hannah did the
fourth the children of my son George
Storrs did & Margaret his wife the
remainder of my property of whatever
denomination to be divided equally between
them and to be delivered to them by my
executors at the time they may become
of age or may die.

of the town of Ellipton my executor
of any the say last will &c. to be sent
into court.
