Wife in the following manner, to wit;

In the first place I give and bequeath unto
my Daughter Margaret Muckler a Negro Girl
named Martha.

In the second place I give & bequeath unto my
Son William Muckler a Negro Boy named Andrew

In the third place I give and bequeath unto my
Son Jacob Muckler a Negro boy named Joseph,

In the fourth place I give & bequeath unto my son
Peter Muckler a Negro Boy named Henry.

all which 2 Negroes are the Children of my Negro
Wench named Nancy. — It is my will and desire
also that at my death, that the above mentioned
Wench Nancy and her increase or issue (if any) —
hereafter, together with all my Real & personal
Estate not hereunto mentioned be sold, and after
all Just debts are paid to be equally divided
amongst my above said Children. — I also nomi-
nate & ordain William Muckler & David Jones
both of the Town of Smyrna as Executors to my Estate
In Witness Whereof I hereunto set my hand &
Seal this first of May 1809.
