In the name of God Amen - I Timothy Hollingsworth late of East Florida planter & now residing in the State of Georgia being of sound & disposing mind do make this my Testament and last will hereby revoking all other acts of this kind - First my Personal expenses and just debts must be paid - Secondly I give devise and bequeath unto my son William all his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land belonging to me at the head of Quaker's Lake in that State containing two hundred and fifty acres more or less and also that other tract or parcel of land upon which I lately lived and called Quaker's containing one hundred and thirty acres more or less, I also give devise and bequeath unto my son William his heirs and assigns one thousand acres of land to which I am entitled in the County of Oglethorpe in that Florida. I also give devise and bequeath to my son William his heirs & assigns all administration and assigns the following negroes, to wit Mary, Tenny, Lee, Clay, Stephen, Adam, and Wm, David & Sarah and Ben in all the same - Thirdly I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Mary the wife of Samuel Bepent as if her sole and proper estate and subject to her control only and to the heirs of her body the following negroes to wit Abby, Harriet, Sarah, Lee, David, Betty, Jane, Matthew and Kelly in all the same and in case my said daughter should die without heirs of her body then I give the said land and negroes to my son William his heirs & assigns - Fourthly it is my will and intention and hereby declared as such that all the Executors of the foregoing my Testament shall give and deliver to the said heirs and assigns as above devised - Fifthly for consideration of the appraisement that I made the day last of my deceased wife I give devise and bequeath unto the said my daughter Mary her heirs and assigns the hundred & fifty acres of land in the County of Oglethorpe in that State that I obtained from Abraham Bepent for laying out and clearing the same for five hundred dollars - Sixthly I make constitute and appoint my son William and my son in law John Jacoby Executors - Considerers of this my Testament and last will - In witness that the within is as said for my Testament and last will I published and declare it as such this 23rd day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen - Signed, sealed, published and declared by Timothy Hollingsworth as and for his Testament and last will in the presence of
