

I Thomas Norris, of the Town of M
Maup, County of Camden and State of Geo
being of sound ^{mind} memory, but considering
the Uncertainty of life, do make this my
last will and testament in manner and
form following, viz. Firstly I give my
Negro man Cato his freedom at the time
of my death and all my wearing apparel
Carpenter's tools, and one hundred feet square
of Lot N^o forty three round his house
for his life time. Secondly, I give my Ne-
gro wench Belinda, her freedom at the
time of my death and a fifty feet square
of land adjoining her house for her life
time. Thirdly I give and bequeath to
my friend William Gibson ~~of the Town of St.~~
Maup my horse Microph, and the Negro
boy named Adam ^{for ever} also a suit of mourning
that may cost ten pounds. Likewise I bequeath
to my friend Alex^r Watt of Savannah I
bequeath a suit of mourning that may
cost ten pounds. And I do hereby call the

knowing fact of my last judgment
and be the in St. Marys Jamaica or else
when I give any ~~by~~ oath to my son
William Norris and his heirs for ever
(who is now residing on the Island of Ja
mrica) So truly and lastly, I do hereby
constitute and appoint my friend Wil
liam Gibson of St. Marys and Alexander
Wall of Savannah my executors to carry
this my last will and testament into
effect rescinding all other heretofore made
as void and of none effect what ever.
