First it is my will that all claims against
me at any period of my life which have
not been satisfied, shall never be affected
by any statute of limitations or other legislative
act.

Second that whatever property I may be entitled
unto at the time of my decease shall remain
in the hands of my wife during the term
of her life,

Third I appoint my wife sole Executrix
to carry this my last will and Testament
into full effect.

in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and fourteen
