my Last Will and Testament.

Item second, I desire and direct that all my
property and Estate, of every kind and
Character, of which I may be seized and
possessed, or in any way entitled at the time
of my death, shall be held in trust by my
said Executor, and that all the interests,
profits or increase arising therefrom shall
be used by the said Executor and his Mother,
my Wife, Ellen, M. Caldwell, for their own separate
use and benefit.

Item third, I desire and direct, that my said
Executor shall have entire and complete
Control of all my property and interests,
to do with and use them to the best of his own
good judgment and discretion, taking
care of and giving comfort and Support
to my said Wife, for and during the
term of her natural life.
