Keston and Sallary his wife, Betty Port Louisa, Scipio and Puby their children also Sarah and her daughters. Tom and Abe and her son Betty, also Julia and her two children Henry & Jane also Rose a young man together with ^{all} their families & free also with my a young fellow and Jack an old man also my part of Negro woman Celia. Together with all ~~the~~ ^{my} ~~land~~ ^{land} and singular ~~the~~ ^{my} stock House and Melton ~~land~~ ^{land} ~~that I possess~~ ^{that I possess} at this time during her widowhood

and in case of second marriage that
the Husband shall have no Control
over the property whatsoever and at her
death to be equally divided Between
my Child or Children and all my
other property not herein enumerated
Lastly I Revoke Constitute and appoint
my beloved Wife & Ann Jane Williams
Executrix and Mr William Gibson and
Mr Lewis Backlot Executors to this
my last Will and Testament Hereby
revoking all other Wills by me made
In witness Whereof I the said William H
Williams have hereunto set my hand and
Seal this Twenty first day of October
Eighteen Hundred and Twenty Three
and in the forty seventh year of the
Independence of the United States of
America
