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Will of William Johnston

In the Name of God

I, William Johnston of the County of Camden State
of Georgia planter being weak in body but of
sound and perfect mind and memory do make
declare and publish this my last Will and testa-
ment in manner and form as follows that is to
say I commend my soul to Almighty God from
Whom it derived its being and my body to the
Earth in the full belief of a Resurrection
First It is my wish and desire in this my Will that
all my last and lawful debts be paid after my

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death as my Executors hereafter named can make
it convenient without serious injury to my Estate
The remainder of my property to be divided among
my Children in the following manner That is
having given to my two eldest daughters M^{rs} Eliza
McKinds and Euphemia Margaret Sinclair
certain property to them known I do direct my
Executors at the decease of Ray Sands to divide
the property given to Eliza McKinds among my
Children equally

Secondly I give bequeath to my daughter Nancy
North part of Lot N^o 3 in the Town of St Marys
Half of tract land now titled (I bought of Garret
Demott at Dark entry) with the improvements thereon
and Two Thousand Seven Hundred dollars which
is to be invested in Stock as the Executors of this
my Will may determine

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah
Jane Three Thousand five Hundred dollars to
be invested in Stock as my Executors shall best
determine and I also give to Sarah Jane my
Negro boy Jim (son to Mary) to her and her
assigns forever

Fourthly I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah
Harriet Cordelia The Other half of tract of
Land bought of Garret Demott at dark entry with
improvements &c thereon (equally) together with
fifteen Negroes and their issue and increase
derived in the right of her mother to wit
Isaacson, Frank, Jimmy, Sarah, Charlotte
Hagar, Prince, John, James, Jim, Mary, Cinda
