In the name of God Amen I William
Niblack being weak in Body but of sound memory
no Calling to mind to mind that it is appointed
all men to Die Do. Constitute and appoint this
my Last Will and Testament in the manner and
and may following First I Recommend my Soul
to God who gave it and my Body to the Earth
to be Buried in a Decent manner and as to the
 worldly Property that it hath pleased God to give
 me it is my will that the Real Property the place
 whereon I now Live and Five Hundred acres jointly
 with my wife Land and Five Hundred and Twenty acres
 my Malters Swamp and one Hundred and fifty
 lying at the Cross Roads be sold to Raise money to pay
 my debts and purchase Cattle and to Enable my
 Family to move to where they may think proper

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As to the Slaves viz Phillis, Henry, Rodney, Mariah, i. froh, Mary, Ben. Lewis, that them and their Increase Remain in and with the James they now are (Mary with Elisabeth) until comes of age or in Case of Death until the next Living comes of age. at which time it is my Will that an Equal Division of the probable share amongst the then surviving heirs as to other Property to wit Horses Cattle Bedding and Household and Kitchen Furniture to Remain and with the Family as the now are for their Support and bringing up also the Plantations and implements of Husbandry to be Divided in like of Division to As the and Susan I and each of them a bed to William the Long Rep. to sell the Old Rifle to be accounted for in Division

I do hereby constitute and appoint James and Esther Niblack my Executor and Executor Carry this my last Will and Testament in force and Effect allowing them to use their Judgment as to the necessity of Selling any of the Land as to the Slaves that is as Directed unless any of them should prove refractory as to make it necessary to do in Hope and Confidence that a Brotherly and Sisterly Love will remain through the Family I Leave you under the Care and Protection of the God of Grace and Mercy Amen
