Constitute & appoint as follows. That my last I
believe up in hopes that it may take effect
Your action; as to my body I hope my friends will
take care that it is decently buried I do hereby
give and bequeath as follows to my Son &
Sister Jane Tennant all my real personal
Estate except a Tract of Land I do give and
bequeath to Cornelius Dickson - about twelve
miles above a aquata - called by the name of
Perryman Island - as follows to Miss Ann
Tennant Six Hundred pounds to be paid
out of the Estate & to Miss Elizabeth Elbert
daughter of Coll. Elbert the sum of two hundred
pounds and to Miss Caty Elbert the sum of
Hundred pounds Sterling and I do hereby
make constitute and appoint my Sister
Jane Tennant, Robert Mac & Samuel Elbert
to be my Executors, & Executors, of and assignors
of this my last will and Testament. Given under
my Hand & Seal and I do Give and bequeath
to my Eldest Son John, & my Child - born
London, all of which I do hereby make

as aforesaid Dated the twelfth day of September 1878
