

In the Name of God Amen: —

I, Hannah H. Collier of the City of Savannah and State of Georgia, wife of Matthew Hall Esq. of the same place, Legate, being of sound and disposing mind memory and understanding, but knowing the uncertainty of this transitory life, do make and publish, that my last will and testament in manner and form following, that is to say: —
I will and desire that all my just debts be paid.
Item I desire that five hundred dollars be set apart for Rebecca Gibbons and the like sum of five hundred dollars for Harriet Gibbons Children of Charles Gibbons, son of my late Brother Joseph Gibbons to be put out at Interest of eight per cent until the said Rebecca and Harriet attain the age of sixteen — that the Interest arising thereon be expended in schooling and clothing them.

And in case of the death of one of them, her share to go to the survivor, but should both die before the age of sixteen, or marriage then the money to revert back to my Estate for the benefit of my residuary Legatee —

Item I give to Mrs Elizabeth Gibbs, during her life, the use of the Buildings on that Part of Lot No one, in West Broad Street; bought by me of Mrs. M. Leans, and used, last year for an office by my Son, Matthew Hall Collier.

Item I give with that the small House and part of the Lot No 2 (two) in Bryan Street, remain in the possession of Lucy, a black woman lately the property of Mrs Ann Hall as long as she lives.

Item I give to the female Appraiser One hundred & fifty dollars.

Item As it was the wish of Mrs Ann Hall that Rebecca Holmes an orphan Child should have one hundred and fifty dollars to be put out at Interest on her obtaining the age of fifteen which will be on the twenty-second day of February next. I leave her that sum.
Item I give devise and bequeath some funds George Jones, Alexander Telfair and George Woodruff Legatee, to be used at the discretion of them and to the Executors of the survivor, for the uses and purposes herein after mentioned the full

 Adams wife of this deponent subscribed their names as
 witnesses to the said execution of the said last will and
 testament at the request of the testatrix in her presence
 and in the presence of each other.
