 Shuffall Cohen pay two hundred dollars each to
 be kept until they give up the income for two use
 alone which is agreeable with the said Moses Shuffall
 but having very little wish it to be decided as agreed
 by as possible. The common clothing belonging to
 me I wish to be given to negro woman Grace for
 her attention and goodness towards me I do hereby
 bequeath to my Brother Doctor Moses Shuffall
 Executor to this my last Will and Testament
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal the fifteenth day of September
