Last will and Testament of H. C. Roberts

I, H. C. Roberts of said State and County, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all wills heretofore made by me.

Item 1. I wish my executor, as soon as possible after my death, to pay my debts.

Item 2. I give to my beloved sons John P. Roberts and Grady L. Roberts my farm described as follows: All of land lot number fifty two (52) in the first (1st) District and fifth (5th) section of Douglas County, Georgia North of Turkey Road and East of point six chains East of Branch except one acre in East end of said lot sold to Smith by Harry, and Eleven acres off of West side of Fractional lot of land number nine hundred and five (915) in the 1st District and 2nd section of Douglas County, Ga said land deeded to H. C. Roberts by H. R. Harry, starting point of said tracts of land to be six chains from Branch running north lot 52 and East along North side of Public Road. I bequeath the above land to my sons John and Grady not that I think any more of them than I do of my other children, but because on account of their care and support of myself and girls they did not get the educational advantages that the others did.

Item 3.

It is my will and I so direct that my executors herein after named sell all the balance of my property and after paying debts and expenses divide the same equally share and share alike with all my children.

Item 4.

It is my will that if any of my children should die and leave heirs at law that the share of such child shall be paid to his child or children.

Item 5.

I do hereby appoint my son Grady L. Roberts executor of this my will.
