to him when he becomes of age, that he
is to render a just and true account of all
the estate which he may receive; that he is
to inquire into and receive all the estate of
said ward, which by law he ought to do;
that he is to maintain said orphan, and
protect his person, and in all respects dis-
charge the duties of a Guardian, by making
proper return, and whatever else the law
requires of guardians.
