granted and by these presents do grant
unto the said John S. Bobo full power
by the tenor of these presents to collect
and gather up all and singular the goods
and chattels right and credits of the said
deceased and to keep the same without
imprachment or waste until legal admin-
istration thereof shall be granted and to render
a just and true account of the same when
thereunto required
