Mary Darby Davis, and also Mrs. C.M.Kirby
my wife One third each of all my personal, real
messays, or effects, left after all my debts and
expenses are paid.

3rd. It is my will and desire that a suit-
able stone, be placed on my grave to mark my last
resting place in this world, and I further desire
that we may be allowed to bury me my lot at some-
where except my own blood and wife.

4th. And I hereby nominate and appoint my
dear and only brother John J.Kirby, now residing
at Douglasville, Ga. my sole Executor of this my
last will and testament.

And I expressly confer upon him Power, as such
Executor to administer my Estate both real and per-
sonal according to the terms of this will, excusing
him from making and Dend, or
making inventory, or appraisement, and I expres-
sly relieve him from making any return to the
Court of Ordinary, or doing anything that will
cause unnecessary expense to my said Estate,
and I leave the management and disbursement to
the good judgement of my said Executor as ample
as I myself were living, and personally managing
and dictating the premises.
