(13 1/2) and one half acres more or less.

Elizabeth Pounds the remainder of my real
estate during her life at her death to be equally
divided between the remaining six children
Sallie C. Matthe V. Stella E. John W. Sallie B.
and Paul E. Pounds provided if any of my
daughters are single at my wife's death the
estate to remain intact and undivided
until all of my daughters are married and
then equally divided among said heirs as
named in item three.

I do hereby appoint my wife Mary
Elizabeth Pounds executrix of this my
Will.
