render a full and true account of all  
the estate which he may receive that the  
said Hon. Clarence is to receive and  
deliver all the estate of said U.S. & M. W.  
Buchanan by law he is bound to do that the  
said Hon. Clarence is to maintain and  
educate said orphan and protect his  
person and in all respects discharge  
of the duties of a Guardian by making  
provision and what ever the  
law requires of Guardians Indian
