I, Henry Watkins, of said State and County, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other wills heretofore made by me.

Item 1. I give, bequeath and devise to my beloved daughters Malinda Touchstone, Beatrice Cantrell and Mary Cantrell my Home Place, consisting of Fifty (50) acres, more or less of lot of land Number One Hundred and Thirty Two (132) and one half acre, more or less of lot of land Number One Hundred and Thirty Three (133) all in the First (1st) District and Fifth (5th) Section of Douglas County, Georgia, but in the division between said daughters Malinda Touchstone is to have my Home of Dwelling House.

Provided that said daughters shall pay the taxes on said place promptly each year and also support me for the remainder of my life, furnishing me food, clothing, washing, ironing and Medical attention, Medicine and all other things to keep me comfortable during the remainder of my life.

Item 2. I give, bequeath and devise all the remainder of my lands that I may die seized and possessed of equally among my children and grandchildren to-wit: my sons Leak Watkins and Whitfield Watkins and my daughters Malinda Touchstone, Beatrice Cantrell, and Mary Cantrell one seventh each and to my grandchildren of my deceased son Geab Watkins one seventh and my grandchildren the children of my deceased daughter formerly Lewis Robinson but Lewis Terry at the time of her death one seventh.

Item 3. I hereby nominate and appoint my son Leak Watkins and my son-in-law James Cantrell Executors of this my will.
