The petition of said Petitioner shows that Nettie
Higgins aged eleven years, and

Higgins aged five years, both of Cherokee County
Alabama, are the children of Francis Higgins
and her husband, John Higgins, both of the State
of Alabama, and County of Cherokee. Your peti-
tioner shows that Francis Higgins the mother
of said minor children, died on the
day of January, 1885, and at her death, was pos-
sessed in her own right of property to the a-
mount of One Hundred and Fifty dollars,
more or less, which said property lies in Dou-
glas County, Georgia, and consists in part, also
of a judgment in her favor, issued from
the Court of ordinary of Campbell Coun-
ty, Georgia, which said judgment, and
the land in Douglas County, the minors
aforesaid are entitled to receive from the
estate of their mother, and that it is
necessary that they should have a guar-
dian appointed to take charge of their
property.

Wherefore, petitioner prays that citation may
issue and be published in terms of the
law, and if no sufficient reason be shown
why he should not, that he be appointed
the guardian of the property of said minors.
