IV. I will bequeath and devise to my son, J.O. Daniell and E.N. Daniell, the following described house and lot in Villa Rica, Carroll County, Ga in town of Villa Rica on Villa Rica, street and fully described in deed from W.D. Whately to E.J. Daniell, to be theirs jointly and absolutely in fee simple forever.

V. I will, bequeath and devise to my wife, Mrs. Martha J. Daniell, for and during her life or widowhood all other property of whatever kind character and description and nature whatever that I may own or possess at my death, the it is my will and desire that at the death of my said wife or at her marriage, should she marry again after my death that all of said property described in this item of my will go, to, and vest absolutely in fee simple forever in the following named children of my wife and myself to-wit: C. J. Daniell, Prudence V. Webb, H.G. Daniell, and Edna E. Daniell.

VI. I hereby appoint my wife Martha J. Daniell Executrix of this my last will and testament, hereby relieving her of making any inventory of my estate or property or appointment thereof, of making bond, and she is only required to probate this Will, and she is further relieved from making returns to the Ordinary of her acts and doings, as to any other court or authority.
