

STATE OF GEORGIA, DOUGLAS COUNTY, I, Mrs. H.L. Harding of Jefferson  
County, Alabama, being of sound and  
disposing mind and memory, do make  
this my last will and testament.

- Item 1. It is my will that all my just debts be paid.
- Item 2. I hereby bequeath and devise all of my property both real  
and personal to my beloved husband absolutely, my husband R.C. Harding.
- Item 3. In the event that my said husband should die without  
disposing of it, it is my will and I so direct that it be  
equally divided among all of the children legitimate of the  
marriage of myself and my beloved husband R.C. Harding share  
and share alike.
- Item 4. It is my will and I so direct that in the event of the  
death of my husband and children and myself leaving no  
heir at law surviving them it is my will and I so direct  
that said property be equally divided between my sister  
Mrs. Lila Mae Weston and Mrs. Emma C. Mollay the sister of my  
husband but in the event of children of myself surviving it  
is my will that the property be and it is hereby willed to  
the child or children surviving.
- Item 5. I nominate and appoint my beloved husband R.C. Harding,  
Executor of this my last will and testament, I direct that  
my Executor be relieved from giving bond and security, and that  
he be relieved from making returns to the Ordinary or Probate  
Judge of his acts, and that after probate of this my last will  
and testament, my Executor be relieved from making any appraisement  
or any accounting to the Ordinary or Probate Judge or any  
other Court of his acts as Executor.
- Item 6. It is my will and I so direct that my husband or children  
or any of the other legatees named when the title is vested  
in him or them be empowered with authority to sell any or  
all of said property of whatever kind and character at public  
or private sale, without any order or authority from the  
Ordinary, Probate Judge or any other Court and to make and  
execute titles to the same without any order from any Court.
