Item 4. I have not willed anything to the heirs of my daughter Mrs. Sarah P. Thompson, deceased, because my said daughter and her family have already received from me their part or as much as their share will amount to.

Item 5. I hereby nominate and appoint my wife Mrs. T.H. Smith, Executrix of this my last Will and I hereby relieve her from giving bond as security.
