Item 4. It is my will and I so direct that my Executor hereinafter named sell all my property both real and personal and pay the same as hereinafter directed.

Item 5. It is my will and I so direct that my Executor pay my unnamed baby boy now about four weeks old the sum of Five Dollars.

Item 6. It is my will and I so direct that after the legacy of Five Dollars to my baby boy is paid and all expenses are paid that the remainder be divided equally between my seven beloved children to-wit;

Item 7. The reason I do not give anything in this will to my wife Mrs. Georgia Webb is because I have already given her as much as her just share of my estate.

Item 8. I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved son T.C. Webb, Executor of this my last will, and I hereby relieve him from giving any bond or security.
