Now therefore know ye that  
I John V. Edgar Esq. Ordinary of  
said County by Virtue of the  
power in me vested as the  
General Assembly have gran-  
ted and by these presents  
do grant unto the said S. M.  
James and John C. James full  
power by the tenor of these  
presents to collect and gather  
up all and singular the  
goods and chattels rights and  
credits of the said deceased,  
and to keep the same without  
impoverishment or waste until  
legal administration thereon  
shall be granted and to render  
up and true account of the  
same when thereunto required  
under my hand and official  
signature this 11th day of July 1882



Georgia By the Honorable the Court

Where John Jones of this County having died in  
testate died intestate having while he lived and at the  
time of his death died lands and tenements goods rights  
and tenements within the County abovesaid by various  
whom the full disposition and power of granting ad-  
ministration of all and singular the goods rights

accounts calculations and reckonings of said ad-  
ministration or and a final and full discharge  
of the same to the Ordinary of said County do of right  
fully believing that the said Tenements goods rights  
and credits of said deceased may be well and truly  
administered committed and disposed of do hereby grant  
unto Samuel Jones and John S. Jones full  
power by the tenor of these presents to administer  
the said lands tenements goods rights and credits  
of said deceased which he have in his lifetime and  
at the time of his death did belong and to ask long receive  
and receive the same and pay the debts in which the de-  
ceased stood bound as far forth as his said tenements  
goods rights and credits will extend to this date and order  
of law being first sworn on the Holy Evangelist of straight-  
ly to do make a true and perfect inventory thereof and  
to hold the same to the Ordinary in the County aforesaid  
in order to be recorded on or before the first day of  
September next ensuing and render a just and true  
account of said administration when therunto re-  
quired and you are hereby ordained constituted and  
appointed Administrators of all and singular  
the said lands and tenements goods rights and credits of  
said deceased
