

Letter of Guardianship

Thomas application in proper form has been made
to have Jas S. Maxwell appointed guardian of the property
of George W. Mangrum & Jefferson S. Maxwell, minor
children of Mangrum & Maxwell, under the age of four-
teen years & the said Jas S. Maxwell has duly solemnized
an oath according to the order of the Court of Chancery
for the guardianship of the property of said orphans and taking
the required oath of Office they it is shown that said Jas S.
Maxwell is entitled to all powers and privileges of General
guardian of said minors, that said Jas S. Maxwell as
such guardian is to safely keep the estate of said
minors to collect & deliver the same to them when they
become of age, that he is to render a just and true
account of all the estate which he may receive, that
he is to engross into and receive all the estate of said
minors which by law he ought to do, & in all respects
discharge the duties of Guardian, by executing proper
returns & whatever else the law requires of guardians
