I, W.W.Daniell, of said State and County, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all wills heretofore made by me.

Item 1. I give and bequeath to my beloved Son J.C.Daniell the following property to-wit: my large wooden bedstead, 1. iron bed, 1 feather bed, 4 pillows, 2 sheets, 1 dresser, 1 washstand, 1 wardrobe, 1 large & 1 small trunk, the trunk belonging to myself and wife during her lifetime, 1 Rocking Chair, 1 plain chair, 1 double leaf table and the Bible thereon, 1 iron bedstead. Also all the Kitchen utensils and furniture of every kind and description, 1 Mattress and 1 set bedsprings.

I also give and bequeath to my Son J.C.Daniell all of the money, notes and accounts that I may have at the time of my death.

Item 2. I give and bequeath to my beloved sons W.W.Daniell, S.T.Daniell, D.J. Daniell and my beloved daughters Mrs. W.W.Baggett and Mrs. H.E.Ashford all the balance of my household furniture my Sewing machine and any other property I may have at the time of my death which is not willed to my son J.C.Daniell.

Item 3. It is my Will and I so direct that my Executors herein after specified in Item 2. of this my will equally between the five children named therein.
