which he owned in his life time and at the time
of his death did belong and to ask demand sue
for recover and receive the Same and to pay
the debts in which the Deceased stood bound
so far forth as his assets will extend according
to Law and then the balance paid to pay over
to the legal heirs and Distributors of the said
deceased and the said N. D. Nathans having
given Bond and Security and Taken the oath
according to Law in such cases necessary to
his full Qualification as Administrator he is by
the ordinary aforesaid and by virtue of
these presents ordained constituted and appointed
Administrator of all and singular the Goods
Chattels rights and credits of said deceased
