I will and direct that my executor hereinafter to be nominated deliver to W. E. Pearce now of McDonough two certain promissory notes signed by the said W. E. Pearce for the sum of \$500.00 and \$300.00 respectively, that is that the same be delivered to the said W. E. Pearce without his paying any sum whatsoever.

Item Four.

I devise and bequeath to Mrs. F. M. Winn, Jr. to be paid out of any funds available, by my executor, the sum of \$2000.00; and to each of the children of the said Mrs. F. M. Winn Jr. to-wit: Gene Winn and Dan Winn, one Liberty Bond each of the par value of \$100.00 or its equivalent in cash.

Item Five.

All the residue of my property of every kind and description, I bequeath and devise to my beloved brother, D. W. Pearce of Douglasville, Ga. in fee simple be the same real or personal property.

Item Six.

I nominate D. W. Pearce now of Douglasville, Georgia as executor of this my last will and testament, with full power, as such, to administer my estate without any order from Court of Ordinary or any other Court or Courts whatsoever; and I expressly direct that he shall not be required to make any inventory of my estate or any report or reports whatever to any Court
