Douglas County. Last will and testament of Peter Carnes,

I, Peter Carnes, of said State and County, being of sound and
disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament.

Item 1st.

I wish my Executor as soon as possible after my death, to pay
all my just debts, if a sale of property should be necessary, I
wish him to sell for calls that which can be most advantageously
used for that purpose, and I authorize him to sell the same at
public or private sale as he may see fit.

Item 2nd.

I wish my Executor to see that my remains are laid to rest
at a suitable place, at what time and place, in the vicinity, his
and the Mountain Top Grave Yard, according to my standing and
sphere in life, and if possible my beloved wife will require me,
require her grave to be marked as mine.

Item 3rd.

If my beloved wife Sophie, should outlive me, I wish all of
my property, personal and real, to be hers, during her natural life,
any personal property that is necessary my Executor may sell, and
retain or interests that may accrue from year to year, may be
sold and reinvested, to the best advantage for her, but the
real property I wish to be left intact, as long as and during
her real life or widowhood, my wish is that my wife Sophie shall
be well provided for and taken care of as long as she lives and
I so instruct my Executor to carry out this my wishes, as intended
to express.

Item 4th.

After the death of my beloved wife Sophie, then all my
possessions shall be divided between my two daughters share and
share alike, Sarah Hawkins & Ida Seales and the real property,
shall be divided as follows; 50 acres of land off lot No. 169
and described in deed, as the North West 4th of said lot is to
be given to my daughter Sarah Hawkins and her wedly heirs,
and 50 acres described in deed as North East fourth of lot No.
170 is given to my daughter Ida Seales and her wedly heirs,
Providing, that the said Sarah Hawkins pays to the said Ida
Seales the sum of \$100.00 or 5 acres of land off of her 50
acres holding the said acre fourth of lot No. 169.

Item 5th.

I do hereby appoint J.J. Kirby, Executor of this my last will
and testament, and do instruct him to carry out the said provisions
as herein set forth.
