

GEORGIA, DOUGLAS COUNTY.

I, Reuben B. Estes of said State and County being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby make, declare and publish this my last Will and testament, hereby revoking and annulling any and all other wills that I may have hereto fore made.

Item One: I desire that all of my just debts be paid by my executor hereinafter nominated without undue delay and that my body be buried in a decent and christian like manner suitable to my station in life.

Item Two: After the payment of all debts justly due I will, bequeath and desire that all of my property of every kind or nature be converted into cash as soon as my executor hereinafter nominated thinks the best price may be obtained for same, and that the proceeds thereof be equally divided between my children, to wit: W.W. Estes, Mrs. Lula Rivers, James Raymond Estes, Joe R. Estes, Mrs. Belle Vansant, Samuel B. Estes and John Estes, but before any division made I desire that each of my children account for any and all advances heretofore made and that may be made hereafter, advances heretofore made set out in the next item below. (the child or children of any deceased child to have share of their parent).

Item Three: Before any division as aforesaid I swear that each of my children be required to account for the advances, made, which was up to Nov. 1st 1925, in the following amounts, to wit:

W.W. Estes for a balance due on note dated July 21st. 1922, and due Dec. 1st. 1922, and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Douglas County, Georgia, same being for originally \$218.00--- and my best recollection is that same should have credits as follows; \$30.00 for mule turned over when said W.W. Estes moved to Atlanta and approximately \$80.00 for Watkins Medicine turned over at said time, interest to be added at 8% per annum----- and also account for \$50.00 advanced to pay out of some trouble in Paulding County, the best I can now determine being due Nov. 1st. 1925 the sum of \$187.56.

No advance having been made to Samuel B. Estes up to this time.

Item Four: The above amounts are for advances made heretofore and represent accrued interest up to Nov. 1st. 1925 and same to draw interest thereafter at 8% per annum. In event of any payment made hereafter by any of said children upon their respective advances they to have credit for the same.

Item Five. I further desire and direct that in event my estate is held liable for any amount by reason of my signing a note with W.W. Estes and S.A. Griffith to E.M. Huffine, dated Dec. 9th. 1915 and due one year after date and
