time of his death did belong and to ask demand
one for recover and receive the same and to
pay the debt in which the deceased stood
bound so far forth as his assets will extend
according to Law and then the Balances paid
to pay over to the legal heirs and distributees
of the said deceased and the said S. Washington
having given bond and account and taken
the oath and performed all other requisites
required by Law necessary to his just
Qualification as Administrator he is by the
ordinary aforesaid and by virtue of these
presents ordained Constituted and appointed
Administrator of all and singular the good
chattels rights and credit of said deceased
